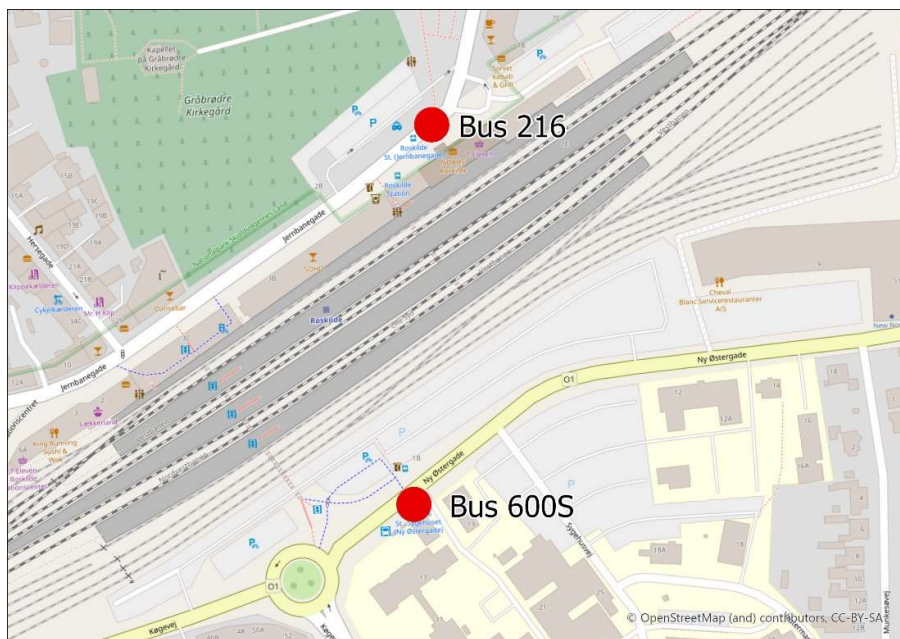


How to travel between Copenhagen and Risø by public transport

Regional trains and bus via Roskilde

- The trip with regional train and bus via Roskilde takes between 50 to 60 minutes
- Regional trains run between Copenhagen Central and Roskilde station approximately every 10 minutes
- From Copenhagen, trains to Roskilde usually leave from tracks 7 or 8
- From Roskilde, trains to Copenhagen usually leave from tracks 4 or 5
- Most trains also stop at Valby station
- The train journey from Copenhagen to Roskilde takes between 25 to 30 minutes
- Twice an hour there are trains which only take around 20 minutes (but without stop at Valby)
- These leave at 3 minutes past every hour from Copenhagen Central and at 37 minutes past every hour from Roskilde station
- The bus ride from Roskilde station to Risø takes around 15 minutes
- Bus 600S to Risø leaves around every 15 minutes from the southern side of Roskilde station (see map)
- Bus 216 leaves from the front (northern side) of Roskilde station (see map) to Risø 1 minute past every hour and returns from Risø to Roskilde station around 9 minutes past every hour
- As trains and busses can be delayed or cancelled it is always a good idea to check your connection in advance on https://rejseplanen.dk/webapp/?language=en_EN

S-train and bus via Ølstykke

- The trip with S-train and bus takes around 60 minutes. It is a good alternative, if you live in the north-western part of Copenhagen (e.g., Nørrebro, Vanløse, Copenhagen NW)
- S-train line C runs every 10 minutes between Copenhagen and Ølstykke with stops in Valby and Flintholm and takes around 38 minutes
- From Ølstykke, Bus 600S runs around every 15 minutes to Risø. The bus trip takes 20 minutes
- As trains and busses can be delayed or cancelled it is always a good idea to check your connection in advance on https://rejseplanen.dk/webapp/?language=en_EN

Biking from Roskilde Station

- An alternative to the bus is to go by bike from Roskilde
- It is around 7 kilometers and, depending on weather conditions and your fitness level, it takes between 20 and 25 minutes
- There are cycle paths all the way (see a suggested route on the map below)
- Since it is quite hilly, a good bike with gears is recommended
- If you cycle after sunset, good bike lights are recommended as there is no road lighting all the way
- Bikes can be taken on the train to Roskilde but require a seat reservation, which must be purchased in advance
