Malene Thygesen and Carsten Bøcker Pedersen will give you an overview of data resources included as well as procedures for gaining access to these valuable data. The data resources covered include the Danish Civil Registration System, geocoded address information for all Danes from 1978 onwards, the National Patient Register, the cause of death register, the medical birth register, as well as social and contextual information from Statistics Denmark.
