

List of Announcements for the ENVS Management Meeting on 19 March 2026

10.1 Status on the Implementation of the Service Car Pool

An agreement has been made regarding a fleet management system: *MileageBook*, which is a standard system that will require some adjustments to meet AU's needs and requirements.

Installation of GPS units and a keyless access solution is underway. The work is nearly completed in Foulum, after which installation will begin in the vehicles in Aarhus.

Once the technical setup is in place, a pilot project will be launched in Foulum, expected to start in the first half of April. Afterwards, the system will be rolled out gradually at other locations. We will be contacted in connection with the preparation of the rollout plan.

10.2 Parcel Lockers (“Mutebokse”)

For the service site meeting on 16 March, two offers for parcel lockers had been obtained. It turns out that leasing is not cost-effective, as it ends up being more expensive than purchasing. The service site committee decided to obtain additional offers and to investigate experiences with parcel lockers in Aarhus. There are significant price differences — and presumably also differences in quality. The matter will be revisited at the next committee meeting.

10.3 Tech Summer Hangout

The Faculty Secretariat is seeking participants from either us or ECOS to join the planning group for the Summer Hangout 2026, with the aim of ensuring input that can help secure participation from our staff.

10.4 Mentor Programme

The faculty management has decided that TECH will establish a mentor programme to strengthen the inclusion of young and newly appointed academic staff (VIP). A pilot project will be launched during 2026 to determine the most suitable model. The intention is to roll out the programme across the entire faculty once a viable structure has been identified.
